## RETURN TO SPA FOR THE TOUR...

After waking up at dawn to rally to the mythical Spa circuit, the Tour Auto Optic 2000 competitors were able to catch the first rays of sun on a fabulous route through Luxembourg as soon as they left the town of same name.

A much awaited moment for all the participants who were not disappointed by the special held on the Spa-Francorchamps circuit. Welcomed on the occasion of an RMU Classic meeting, the Tour Auto Optic 2000 reorganised their grids to be able to free the track at 1 pm. Together – one hundred – of the cars running in regularity set off at the same time on the track, whereas the competition was separated in two grids instead of three. In the first grid, the show was provided by the two Porsche 904 GTs belonging to Miloe and Marc Duez; in the second grid, there was much battling between the leaders of the VHC et GHI classifications.

After a selective special, close to the border, the competitors drove on towards the last but one stage of the Tour Auto Optic 2000, the Marcq en Baroeul Racecourse, close to Lille. For the classifications: Shaun Lynn and Pierre Alain France's GT40s had Ludovic Caron's Cobra between them in VHC; whereas the Linwoods have taken the first place in Regularity.
